

## Sew from the Heart Student Supply List

Class Name: **Basic Needle Felting - Wool Pincushions #20134**

Teacher: **Judy Danz**

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Date: **Wednesday, September 30th**

Time: **1pm - 4pm**

We will learn how to use the Bernina Needle Punch Attachment while making a wool pincushion. This project is a great introduction to Wool Fleece Applique, a needle felting technique. You will get at least one pincushion made in class, possible 2 or 3. These are addicting, so plan to make several.

Note: see the pattern for more details on the supply list. My list does vary some from the pattern because as usual, I have a few tricks up my sleeve to show you. So be certain you follow my list for the class.

### Supplies Needed:

- Pattern: Pure Wool's **Wool Pincushions** pattern - **REQUIRED**.
- Wool roving in various floral and greenery colors. The Pure Wool collections *The Classics* or *Mango Grove* would work great for any of the projects in the pattern.
- Sewing machine with the wool felting attachment or a wool felting machine and Basic Sewing Kit. You may want to have extra machine felting needles on hand too in case you break one.
- Hand felting needles - Colonial hand needles or extra Bernina needles – **REQUIRED**. We will hand felt to baste the berries in place. The Bernina needles will work, but are harder to hold.
- Needle felting foam – **REQUIRED**.
- Thick green thread to use for flower stems – options are Oliver Twist yarn pack, QRI Boucle, thin wool yarn or Pearl Cotton #8. One of the shop samples used the wool roving too, so that is an option as well.
- 1/8<sup>th</sup> yard medium to light weight clear vinyl -OR- a couple Ziplock Freezer baggies work as well. I will show you a great technique for making templates.
- Sharpie ultra fine point permanent marker.
- Pin cushion stuffing if you are making the pin cushion – wool scraps, poly stuffing.
- Chenille, darning or tapestry needle with large enough eye for stem thread.
- Pen or pencil and notebook.
- Scissors.
- Marking pencil.
- Straight pins (glass- or flower-headed pins recommended).
- Seam ripper (Clover Ergonomic seam ripper recommended).

*Includes the following items: Thread, good quality fabric scissors, small scissors or thread nips, straight pins, 6" seam gauge or ruler, seam ripper, fabric marker, assorted machine needles, pen and paper for notes, any other items you commonly use. Please call us with any questions.*
