CLASS DESCRIPTION: Ever wondered how you could use those neat decorative stitches in your machine? Make a table runner and also get the directions for a cozy quilt from Bernina.

CATEGORY: Quilting Embroidery Software Garment Fiber Arts Other

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner Confident Beginner Intermediate Advanced

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- **2/3 yard focus fabric (recommend non-striped fabric)**
- **$\frac{3}{4}$ yard solid (or reads as solid) fabric to coordinate with focus fabric**
- **$\frac{1}{4}$ yard fabric for inner border**
- **1 yard fabric for outer border and binding**
- **1 2/3 yard fabric for backing**
- **Decorative thread (Isacord, Rainbows, King Tut, YLI, metallic, etc)**
- **Ass't. sewing machine needles for your thread selection (ex: metallic or Metafil for metallic threads, 90/14 embroidery, sharp or top stitch for Sulky 30 weight threads*)**
- **Bottom Line or other bobbin thread**
- **Piecing thread (cotton or poly)**
- **Embroidery thread (Isacord, monofilament, etc.)**
- **Metal thread stand may be helpful to you**
- **Thread net may also be helpful**
- **Batting size 30 x 57"**
- **$\frac{1}{2}$ yard lightweight tear-away stabilizer**
- **3/4 yard fusible interfacing (Armo Weft, Pellon or other) or 1 package Lite Steam-a-Seam**
- **Rotary cutter, mat and ruler (6 x 24 or other)**
- **Marking pen or pencil that will show up on your solid fabric**
- **Sewer's Aid (optional)**
- **Fray Check (optional)**
- **505 Spray Baste if you wish to use for quilting**

NOTE: if you have done a stitch-out of your machine's decorative stitches, or have a chart of stitches, bring it along. If you can preprint the stitch conversion chart (19 pages) from the Bernina website, that will be useful in class. (www.berninausa.com)

***NOTE:** I have lots of Sulky thread and will bring it to supplement your threads.

Feet Required: clear foot #34/34C, or other zig-zag foot, patchwork foot #37 or 57, Quilting seam guide (the metal bar that came with your machine and inserts through back of foot), walking foot, BSR if desired for quilting
