CLASS DESCRIPTION: A quick and easy pillow pattern, but with lots of pizzazz! Cover one pillow, make sleeves to suit your mood! You will go home with a completed pillow wrap.

CATEGORY: Creative

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner  Confident Beginner  Intermediate  Advanced

PREREQUISTE (If any): machine mastery classes

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- Pattern (required): It's a Wrap Pillow Sleeves by Vanilla House
- Basic pillow cover: 1/2 yd fabric (2/3 yd if a vertical print is desired)
- Pillow Sleeve with ties: 5/8 yd print to coordinate with cover
- Pillow Pockets - needs three fabrics for pocket:
  - Pocket flap: scrap of fabric
  - Main pocket trim and inner pocket: 1/3 yd
  - Main pocket: 1/3 yd
  - See pattern for exact sizes needed for the three pockets if using scraps of fabric for pockets.
- Pillow Sleeve with tabs - please refer to the pattern for fabric requirements.
- Sewing machine, Bernina clip-on or clear acrylic table and basic sewing kit.
- Bernina #37 or #57 Patchwork foot, or equivalent for your make and model machine. This project uses 1/4" seams
- Bias Binder (optional) - easy way to make the ties, I will bring one to use too.
- Rotary cutting tools: rotary cutter with sharp blade, 24" ruler, 14" square up.
- 16" pillow form, new or recycled!
- Button for pocket decoration (optional).
