CLASS DESCRIPTION: Get in the Halloween spirit with some really EASY placemats! Learn a quick way to appliqué with fusible web and your machine.

CATEGORY: Quilting Embroidery Software Garment Fiber Arts Other

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner Confident Beginner Intermediate Advanced

PREREQUISITE (If any): LTQ classes are helpful but not required.

SUPPLIES REQUIRED **FOR 2 PLACEMATS**: (Be sure to purchase early)

- **Book: Toppers for Every Table from House of White Birches**
- **2 scraps of brown fabric each $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " for pumpkin stems**
- **$\frac{1}{2}$ yard black fabric for border**
- **$\frac{3}{8}$ yard white fabric with black dots for background**
- **$\frac{3}{4}$ yard narrow Halloween stripe for blocks and binding**
- **$\frac{1}{2}$ yard mottled orange for pumpkins**
- **$\frac{2}{3}$ yard backing fabric**
- **2 pieces cotton batting 20 x 20"**
- **$\frac{1}{4}$ yard 18" wide paper-backed fusible web (or a package of 9x12" Lite Steam-a-Seam 2)**
- **$\frac{1}{2}$ yard medium weight stabilizer (cut-away or tear-away)**
- **Rotary cutter, mat, ruler**
- **Cotton or polyester thread for piecing**
- **Black thread for satin stitching around pumpkin faces (cotton, poly or rayon)**
- **Cotton, polyester or monofilament thread for quilting**
- **505 Spray Baste**
- **Binding clips (look like spring-open metal hair clips) optional**
- **Travel iron and pressing mat are nice to have**

Feet Required: #57 or #37, #34C or 34 or other zig-zag foot, walking foot, BSR if desired for quilting

*****NOTE:** If you have time and wish to precut your fabric, refer to book, page 6 for first cut directions for orange fabric only. You could also cut 4 WOF strips $2\frac{1}{4}$ " wide from striped fabric and prepare the binding if you wish.
