CLASS DESCRIPTION: It takes only a small amount of fabric, but it sure packs a visual punch! The second night we'll talk about quilting templates, and you can quilt this or other projects.

PREREQUISITE (If any): LTQ classes are helpful but not required.

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- **Book: Let's Do Lunch (Atkinson Designs)**
- **1 fat eighth (9 x 21") bold polka dot fabric**
- **2 fat eighths (9 x 21" each) allover, non-directional accent prints**
- **1/2 yard of background fabric**
- **3/8 yard of backing fabric**
- **1/4 yard binding**
- **Cotton batting 15" x 42"**
- **Rotary cutter, mat, ruler**
- **Piece of flannel or flannel-backed plastic tablecloth, approx. 15 x 42"**
optional but helpful for laying out blocks
- **Cotton or polyester thread for piecing**
- **Cotton, polyester or monofilament thread for quilting**
- **505 Spray Baste**
- **Binding clips (look like spring-open metal hair clips) optional**
- **Travel iron and pressing mat are nice to have**
