CLASS DESCRIPTION: Use some pretty fall fabrics to make one of two different pumpkin-shaped placemats to brighten your table.

SUPPLIES REQUIRED to **make 1 placemat**...buy extra fabric if you wish to make 2 or 4!

- **Pattern; Pumpkin Party #ST-917, by Susie C. Shore Designs**
- **$\frac{1}{2}$  yard orange cotton fabric for pumpkin**
- **1 FQ of fall print fabric for pumpkin center**
- **2 scraps brown fabric for stem 4x4" each**
- **2 scraps green fabric for leaf 5" each**
- **Optional: 1 FQ black fabric if making a Jack-o-Lantern face**
- **$\frac{1}{2}$  yard Pellon fusible fleece**
- **$\frac{1}{4}$  yard paper-backed fusible webbing (or Steam-a-Seam 2, lite or reg.)**
- **12 x 18" sheet template plastic (or something to trace pattern on)**
- **Permanent marking pen for template plastic**
- **Marking pen or pencil that will show on the back of print fabric**
- **Matching and contrasting cotton or poly thread for quilting**
- **Rotary cutter, mat and ruler**
- **No-stick Pressing cloth such as Teflon, or parchment paper**
- **Travel iron and pressing mat optional but helpful**
- **Scissors for cutting paper and fabric**
