DESCRIPTION: You will learn a great technique for saving all those t-shirts left from all the fun times and turning them into a quilt of memories to be used and cherished. This class will help you learn some ways to make the blocks for this quilt and then put them together in interesting designs. In class you will make a small wallhanging or start your very own t-shirt memory quilt.

PREREQUISITE (If any): some sewing and quilting knowledge

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

Book: "Making a T Shirt Quilt – The Scrapbook You Can Sleep Under" by Lauren Kingsland

Tools:

- Paper scissors
- Pencils for light and dark fabric – silver or yellow plus standard grey
- Graph paper – several sheets. 10/inch is best but other sizes will do
- Post-it glue stick or scotch tape
- Calculator
- Large square ruler (12" or bigger)
- Rotary cutter, mat, acrylic rulers (18" or 22" long)
- Lightweight knit fusible interfacing – 1 yd. or more as needed – see below
- Muslin pressing cloth – ½ yd.
- Straight pins
- Fabric cutting scissors
- Thread – high quality cotton – medium grey or color to match

Material: Prewash quilting cotton fabrics. You'll need approximately:

1 yard for sashing

2 yards for backing, bording and binding

Select medium values in colors that pick up the colors in the shirts. Batiks, abstracts, and multi-colored prints work well. If in doubt, bring several fabrics.

4 to 6 shirts (washed and not wrinkled) – select shirts that have a theme or connection to one another. **Do not** cut up your t-shirts ahead of time!

Fusible tricot knit interfacing like Fusi-Knit – allow ½ yd. per shirt.

Quilter's Dream cotton batting –suggested – 45"x60" piece

Please remember that the materials suggested to bring are only for the small wallhanging you will make in class. If you are making a larger quilt, you will need more of all the materials.
