Description: Create your own version of Sarah’s stunning design!
In session 1, you will learn how to prepare your fabric for embroidered appliqué to get precise results.
In session 2, you will learn how to stabilize your fabric for perfect results every time; how to place a design exactly where you want it on your background fabric so that multiple hooping becomes a breeze; how to create perfect results with your appliqué shapes for a simply stunning result.
Got an 830 and a jumbo hoop? This is the perfect project to see what it can do! Got a large oval hoop or a hoop-it-all quilters square? The “baby” version will work beautifully for you.

Prerequisite: You must have completed all Machine Mastery and Embroidery Master classes

Supplies Required: **Heather Feather – the “Be You” Quilt CD** by Sarah Vedeler
Fabric requirements are on the CD. Make the whole quilt, or just one block as a cushion cover. Or something in between!
Designs from the CD pre-loaded onto your machine or USB stick.
Sewing machine, embroidery module, embroidery bobbin case.
Jumbo hoop with hoop template for 830 owners.
Hoop-it-all Quilters Square if you have one for 730 and equivalent machines, or a large oval hoop with hoop template.
Stabilizer: OESD Stabil-Stick Tearaway and Fusible Polymesh
OR Floriani Perfect Stick Tearaway and Heat N Sta Tearaway
A selection of Isacord embroidery threads.
Lightweight fusible webbing.
1-2 bobbins pre-wound with appropriate color of Superior Bottom Line bobbin thread.
70/10 or 80/12 Organ sharp embroidery needles, or needle size appropriate for the thread you will be using.
Fine marking pen that will show on the fabric you will be stitching onto.
Sewline pencils work great.
Curved tip embroidery scissors.
Scotch tape.
Rotary cutter, rulers and mat.
A mini iron that will fit easily into your hoop.
